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Landscape Maintenance Rules & Regs Review

From October of 2018, landscape maintenance needed some revision, redirection, clarification and some tweaking due to the multiple changes "popping up" within our landscape. MBCA Rules and Regulations need to be observed when changing or adding plantings; this is part of Condominium Living. Over the years, revisions have been made to continue, to help protect and provide a pleasant environment. It is the responsibility of the Board to administer and enforce the Rules & Regs. However, it's the responsibility of each owner to cooperate and adhere to them. The following is a review of Rule and Regulation #1, titled "Landscape Maintenance".

Landscape Maintenance

A. Unit owners should not give on-site instructions to any maintenance individuals. Any concerns should be addressed the Board of Directors via the helpline or by writing to the Board at the address above.

- B. East Side (2519, 2523, 2531, 2535, 2539, 2543, 2547, 2551)
 - Existing plantings by homeowners are "grandfathered" based on photos as of 9/9/18.
 The upkeep of the grandfathered plantings continues to be a unit owner responsibility.
 - 2. If plantings are not maintained in a timely manner or become a nuisance to
 - neighbors, the MBCA has the right to:
 - (a) have work done at the expense of the owner or
 - (b) remove the plantings.
 - This also applies to weeds in patio area.
- 3. Future plantings will be done solely by MBCA. This includes sides of end buildings.
- C. West Side (2567, 2571, 2575, 2579)
 - Existing plantings by unit owners are "grandfathered" based on photos as of 9/9/18. The upkeep of the grandfathered plantings continues to be a unit owner responsibility.
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- 3. Shared mulched "islands" between 2 units may be altered by unit owners and therefore maintained by me owners. Both unit owners of shared areas must agree on changes and follow with upkeep, maintenance and set of maintenance: this includes the sides of end units.
 - 4. The rules outlined above also pertain to areas where there are front, side and rear sidewalk entrances.
 - There are no plantings allowed on the back rock wall area behind building 2579, as plantings on the rock wall could compromise the stability of the rocks.
-). No individual landscaping shall extend to common areas.

Trash & Recyclables Bin Reminder

Please return your black trash bin and the green recyclable bin to your garage the same day as pick-up. On Fridays*, yes, to the inside of your garage. If you won't be home to tuck it away, perhaps ask a neighbor for a favor. (*Friday is our usual day for pick-up, if a holiday during that week ~ it is then the following day, Saturday.)

Lumens Lowered

Did you notice the outside lighting change? The Board addressed the "Lambeau" lighting and had the lumens lowered. This change brought our electric bill down, approximately \$50 per month.

Sump Pumping

The count is 39, yes we have 39 units that house a sump pump located in their basement. One pump covers several units. If you are a unit that houses one of the pumps, you were recently contacted and necessary maintenance was carried through.

Black Topping



Areas on the East side are being corrected with new asphalt. One of the concerns was the crumbling of some asphalt, another is the "leveling" in certain driveway areas. Resurfacing/resealing* will also be carried through. (West side had their driveway issues addressed in the previous year.)

*Once the sealant has been applied, there is a mandatory TWO DAY cure time. The cure time will extend the longevity of the sealant. During this time period, ABSOLUTLEY NO DRIVING allowed on the treated asphalt. Alternate parking options during the time are as follows:

- ~ Extra parking in front of 2551
- ~ The 9 spots on the west side of our Greenspace (in front of CCC)
- ~On the street, Telluride Trail

The area in front of 2551 will be budgeted for regrading and aligning in 2020.

Cameras & Filming

- Where do you have your outdoor surveillance cameras posted? Are they interfering with your neighbors privacy? Recent issues have been brought to the Board's attention.

Siding Cleaning [

The washing of the outside siding of each of our 12 building has begun. An advance notice was (and will be) posted to your email address that you have on file. Homeowners without an email are given a personal notice. Through these Building Communication Messages, the Board can pass along pertinent info from Badger Window Cleaning. For instance, they have requested to have all windows and doors closed and any items, furniture included, on you patio/decks/porch type entrances moved away from the building. Potted plants or decor perched near your entrances also need to be temporarily moved. The vendor started on the East side, 5/29. Only a few buildings have received their notice at the time of this Bugle publication.

(Vendor activity is weather related. Badger has scheduled MBC for Wednesdays and Thursdays until project is complete.)
